

THE GREATEST ARMENIAN ATHLETES SESSION PLAN

Duration: 60 minutes (or as appropriate for your curriculum)

Description:

This knowledge-based session is designed for children ages 8-14, during which they will delve into the world of Armenian athletes who have conquered and excelled at different sports, including weightlifting, wrestling, chess, football/soccer, boxing, tennis and gymnastics.

Many Armenian athletes have been a source of inspiration and served as role models to young children. They have marked their success not only in Armenia but also around the world. In this session, children will learn about the history of sports in Armenia and the various prominent athletes in Armenia and Diaspora who have achieved great successes. Through this session, children will appreciate the importance of sports and how merging it with national identity can lead to international wonders.




THE GREATEST ARMENIAN ATHLETES



ARTHUR ALEXANIAN - WHITE BEAR

Arthur Alexanian is the most renowned and decorated Armenian Greco-Roman wrestler of the 21st century. He is an Olympic Champion, a four-time World Champion and a six-time European Champion.



SUSI KENTIKIAN - KILLER QUEE

Susi Kentikian was named the first ever WBA female Super Champion during the 2009 World Boxing Association convention in Colombia. It was announced that this belt would be called **"Susi Kentikian belt"** for all other future Super Champions.



Historical records indicate that two Armenian princes, who later became kings participated in the original ancient Olympic games – **Trdat** III having won at wrestling during the 265th Olympics held in 281 AD, and **Varazdat**, who won the boxing event of the 291st Olympics, heldin 385.

Tigran Petrosyan is an Armenian chess player who learned to play chess at the age of 8 and brought a widespread recognition of chess in Armenia after becoming the World Chess Champion from 1963 to 1969.

LEVON ARONIAN

Levon Aronian is an Armenian world-known chess prodigy, who earned the title of grandmaster in 2000, at age 17.





YOURI DJORKAEFF

Youri Raffi Djorkaeff is a French Armenian footballer/soccer player who was the first Armenian to be crowned a World Cup winner.In his career, Djorkaeff scored 225 goals.

KAREN KHACHANOV

Karen Khachanov is a Russian Armenian tennis player whose name steadily went up in the list of ATP (Association of Tennis Professionals). He started playing tennis at the age of three.



NAZIK AVDALIAN

In the weightlifting world, Nazik Avdalyan is known to be the first-ever woman from Armenia to win a world championship in any sport.



15-year-old Hamlet Manukyan became two-time world champion in the Rings exercise final, and became a gold medalist with 13.633 points at World Artistic Gymnastics Championships held in Antalya, Turkey in April, 2023. Kokh /Чпри/ is an ancient form of wrestling that has its origins in the Armenian Highlands and is believed to be at least 1,500 years old.







